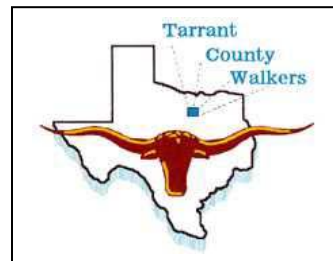

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 30:

Take I-30 to University Drive (exit 12) and go south. Travel past the Zoo on your left. Turn right on Canty. Go 2 blocks to Wabash and turn right. University Baptist Church is at 2720 Wabash Avenue.

NOTE: You will see University Christian Church on the corner of University Drive and Canty. This is not the Start Point. Go 2 blocks on Canty to Wabash...to University Baptist Church.



We Tarrant County Walkers are “Volkssporters”. This is a German word that translates literally to “People’s Sport” and describes non competitive walking, bicycling and swimming events having very lenient time limits.



There are clubs like ours all over the world belonging to the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and in the United States, the American Volkssport Association (AVA).

LOCATION:

Start Point for both walks is University Baptist Church, 2720 Wabash Avenue, Fort Worth, TX 76109. For directions, please refer to map in this brochure.

This walk will wind through the beautiful TCU campus and neighboring areas.



Fun Facts about TCU:

The campus is spread over 268 acres. It was founded in 1873 by brothers Addison and Randolph Clark in Thorp Spring, Texas as AddRan Male and Female College, with 13 students. It moved to Waco where it became Texas Christian University in 1902, moving to Fort Worth in 1910 when the Waco facility burned.

START TIME:

8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
Walkers must be off trails by 2:00 p.m.

TRAILS:

Trail is rated 1+, mostly on paved city streets and park paths. Some very small hills and short stretches of gravel surface. Both walks are suitable for strollers. Trails are marked and walkers are provided maps.

DISTANCES:

Trail is 10 kilometers (6.2 miles), or choose the 5K route (3.2 miles). Participants may walk twice on the same card for IVV distance credit at no additional charge.

AWARDS:

There are **NO** “A” awards. “B” awards are available.

REFRESHMENTS:

Food and beverages available at start point. Water (for pets, too) available at start point and check points. It is recommended all walkers carry extra water. Restrooms at start sites.



ELIGIBILITY:

Open to everyone. Adults must accompany children under 12. **Walk at your own pace.** **All walkers** must register and obtain a start card. Card must be turned in at finish.

PETS:

Permitted but, must be on leash. Please clean up after your pet if necessary. Again, water at start and checkpoints.
