**Directions to Farmersville**

Farmersville is located in Collin County, in northeast Texas. We are 35 miles northeast of Dallas, located near the intersection of Highway 380 and Highway 78. We are located 15 miles east of McKinney, and 15 miles west of Greenville.

Directions to the Historic Onion Shed and downtown from Highway 380:

**Coming from the West:** Directions from QuikWash Car Wash on the corner Hwy 380 & 75 in McKinney (travel time 23 minutes / 17 miles) --- Follow Hwy. 380 East through Princeton and across Lake Lavon bridge. At the red light in Farmersville you will see Brookshire's Grocery on your right. Take the first exit (on right) past red light to TX-78 toward Blue Ridge. Less than one mile is Farmersville Parkway, just past First National Bank of Trenton. Turn right on Farmersville parkway and drive less than a mile to the second stop sign. The Historic Onion Shed is straight ahead. Turn left (½ block) to parking beside the park and behind the Chamber of Commerce and City Hall (corner of Hill Street and Main Street).

**SPONSOR:** Plano Walking Club (AVA-124)

**ELIGIBILITY/TYPE OF EVENT:** 10/5km Noncompetitive.

Walk, jog or run at your own pace. It is open to all and families are encouraged to participate. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone MUST register and carry a Start Card and turn it in at the FINISH. This event normally will be held regardless of weather conditions.

**Farmers & Fleas Market after your walk:**

In its 12th year, Farmersville Main Street project is a combination Farmers Market and Flea Market, featuring fresh produce, plants, food, crafts, collectibles, jewelry and more. The Market was established to assist sellers in the direct marketing of their products, and to attract customers to downtown Farmersville. It is our version of a "trades days" market.

**STARTING POINT & ADDRESS:** Farmersville Onion Shed, 151 S. Main St., Farmersville, TX 75442



**PARKING ADDRESS:** 201 S. Main St. Park behind the Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center. Turn onto Hill Street off Main between the Onion Shed and the Chamber of Commerce.

**START TIMES AND FINISH TIMES:** 9 AM to 12 NOON. Walkers must be off trails by 3 PM.

**DISTANCES:** 10km/5km (6.2mi/3.1mi). The route may be walked twice on the same Start Card for 20km Distance Credit.

**PETS:** Pets are allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times. Pets are not allowed in any buildings. Please pick up after your pet.

**AWARD:** Girl Scout patch. Available only for Girl Scouts after either a 5 or 10km has been completed for credit.

**ROUTE:** Both routes start out on the paved Chaparral Trail. (Many geocache locations exist along this Trail.) At the split the 10k route continues out Chaparral Trail for another 1.5 miles then returns back and continues on same route as the 5k touring some of the Farmersville homes. The walk continues through the Historic downtown square where walkers can shop, enjoy a bite to eat and discover the place that World War II hero Audie Murphy claimed as his hometown. The paved trail is suitable for strollers. Trail Rating 1+.

**WATER/RESTROOMS:** Water and restrooms will be available at the Start, on Trail and Finish. Please carry your own water.
