



DIRECTIONS TO THE START/FINISH:

From I-10 (San Antonio): Exit 508 (Hwy 16). Turn left, go approx. 2 miles. Turn right on Hwy 27 (Main St). Go approximately 2 miles. Inn of the Hills Resort & Conference Center is on the left at 1001 Junction Hwy, next to Bank of the Hills.

From Hwy 16 South: Turn left on Hwy 27, go approximately 2 miles. Inn of the Hills Resort & Conference Center is on the left at 1001 Junction Hwy.

ELIGIBILITY/TYPE OF EVENTS: Noncompetitive. Walk, jog, run at your pace. Open to all, and families are encouraged to participate. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone **MUST** register & carry a start card to turn in at the FINISH. **STARTING POINT:** Inn of the Hills Resort & Conference Center, **STARTING POINT ADDRESS:** 1001 Junction Hwy. 830-895-5000

BRIDGE walk starts at Elm Creek Park. **10k/5k**
DOWNTOWN walk starts at the Inn of the Hills. **10k/5k**
GUADALUPE RIVER TRAIL walk starts at Louise Hays Park. **10k/5k**
HUNT-HILL COUNTRY walk starts at the Hunt Store in Hunt. **10k/5k**
RESIDENTIAL walk starts in Riverhill Development. **10k/5k**
SCHREINER UNIVERSITY walk starts at the Cailloux Theater. **11k/5k**
START/FINISH TIME: Daily, dawn to dusk. Events will take place regardless of weather.
TRAILS: Walk on the LEFT when walking in the streets and watch traffic carefully at all times. Walk on the RIGHT on the Guadalupe River Trail.

The BRIDGE walk goes through scenic Elm Creek Park and across the Guadalupe River. Paved surfaces except for Elm Creek Park trail. The Park has benches and tables for resting and picnics, and some shade. Suitable for strollers; wheelchairs may have difficulty due to gravel surface of Park trail. Rated 1B. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Bridges-Spanning the USA, Doin' the LA Purchase, Honoring Our Flag, Take a Walk in a City Park, Walking the USA, A-Z, You'll Never Walk Alone**

The DOWNTOWN route follows the Guadalupe River to Riverside Nature Center. Continues to the lush Louise Hays Park & new River Trail, then wanders through the charming downtown. Not recommended for strollers or wheelchairs due to steep steps in park. Paved surfaces, except for the park. Rated 2C. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Bridges-Spanning the USA, Doin' the LA Purchase, Honoring Our Flag, Lakes and Reservoirs, National Register of Historic Places, Take a Walk in a City Park, Walking the Path of Inventions, Walking the USA, A-Z**

The GUADALUPE RIVER TRAIL WALK follows the scenic river along a newly completed 10 feet wide concrete trail that accommodates hikers, runners, bikers and pets. Majestic cypress trees, splash pad, charming dog park, and beautiful natural areas. Restaurants and shops one block away in the downtown area. Rated 1A. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Doin' the LA Purchase, Make a Wish at a Water Fountain, Take a Walk in a City Park, Walking the USA, A-Z, You'll Never Walk Alone**

The HUNT-HILL COUNTRY WALK starts at the historic Hunt Store. You will walk through peaceful neighborhoods, a hilly, scenic subdivision, and along the beautiful cypress-lined Guadalupe River. Suitable for strollers but wheelchairs may have difficulty due to the hills. Rated 2B. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Bridges-Spanning the USA, Doin' the LA Purchase, Honoring Our Flag, US Post Offices, , Walking the USA, A-Z, You'll Never Walk Alone**

The RESIDENTIAL route winds through the beautifully landscaped, residential homes of Riverhill and past the Museum of Western Art. Paved surfaces are suitable for strollers, but wheelchairs may have difficulty due to hills. Rated 2B. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Doin' the LA Purchase, Honoring Our Flag, Points of Reference, Walking the USA A-Z, You'll Never Walk Alone, Water Towers**

The SCHREINER UNIVERSITY route winds through the campus and residential streets, to a nature trail in Singing Wind Park, with views of the hills and the Guadalupe River. Paved and unpaved surfaces, and is suitable for strollers. Wheelchairs may have difficulty due to hills and gravel surface on the nature trail. Rated 2B. **AVA SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Doin' the LA Purchase, Honoring Our Flag, Take a Walk in A City Park, Walking the Path of Inventions, Walking the USA, A-Z, You'll Never Walk Alone**

REGISTRATION: No preregistration. EVERYONE must register themselves and pick up START cards. A separate card is required for each event and is returned at the completion of events. No refunds.

CREDIT: A walker can walk a YRE as often as desired, and can stamp his or her book for the event each time it is walked. You may also get unlimited IVV Distance Credit. Each route may be walked TWICE on the same Start Card/Same Day for double Distance Credit.

REFRESHMENTS/ RESTROOMS: Water and restroom facilities are available at the Inn of the Hills, at the downtown Visitor Center (715 Water Street), and on the River Trail. Refreshments: Inn of the Hills Hotel and on all walks (except Residential and Guadalupe River Trail).

PETS: Pets on a leash are welcome on all walks, BUT they are *not* allowed in the lobby of the Inn of the Hills, or at the Riverside Nature Center on the DOWNTOWN walk. Water for pets must be carried on all walks.
